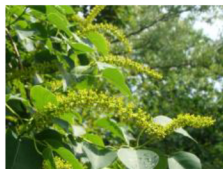


Let's Go Find Some Fall Fruits!

Location : Near Shinjuku Gate



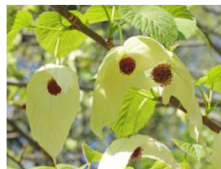

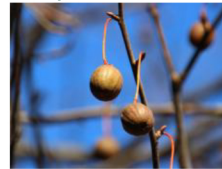

Location : Near Shinjuku Gate



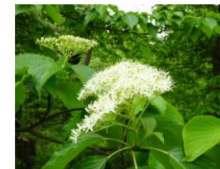

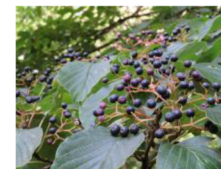

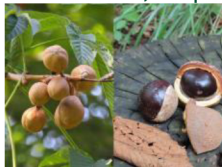

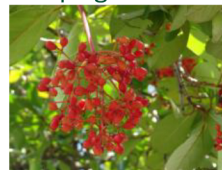

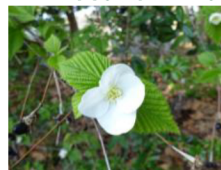
